It is now summer in Malawi & the main agricultural season is almost under way. Working in rural areas during this time becomes a challenge, especially to gather people for learning, as most people start farming.

Follow Me

Patterson recently went to a leadership conference 'I learnt about mission & vision. Malawi has depended on other people for a long time, but I now know that God has something for everyone to do. We should start with loving our neighbour where we are, not always waiting for outside help.'

Follow Me 6 is currently being translated – thank you again to Bill Dixon for writing this material. We still have 7 pioneering students from the first ever group that gathered with Tom, as the idea for FM was being developed.

Pastor Juma 'I was attending Follow Me 3, but stopped as I was sent to lead a Church in Mozambique. God is using me because of the FM foundation in my life & I am using the FM teaching style too, I miss FM a lot.'

CHE (Community Health Evangelism)

Our work in 5 villages continues with 49 volunteers we have trained to deliver health lessons to their neighbours. Below 2 of our interns describe what they have learnt by being part of it.

Jameson 'to my surprise CHE is very different to aid. Also I discovered I am a steward to everything that God created, to care for it & to worship Him. My hope is to teach people to depend on themselves & their community first, by using locally available resources.' Japhael 'I have learnt to create an environment in the village, where together we stimulate & inspire peoples' thinking, this leads to new ideas & a change of behaviour. When I go to the village I need to teach lessons according to the community's needs, not what I want them to learn.'

UK

Tom has just returned from a trip to Malawi – more in the next update. We meet with the Trustees in November to evaluate & enhance plans for the next 5 years. We hope to communicate this early next year with a new website, new style newsletters and clear opportunities on how to engage with the Trust, from individuals to churches. We are moving house imminently to help give us roots as a family. Tom is still being monitored by the hospital, for the liver parasite and has another scan soon.
