The rains are coming to an end and we hope for a good harvest.

This month we highlight our Follow Me (FM) work. FM is a collection of 6 yearlong courses, serving local church leaders from a variety of church affiliations. Material has been written specifically for us by our friend Bill Dixon.

Chippo 'I took for granted that rural church leaders will have a basic knowledge of the Bible. As we are going through an overview of the Old Testament books in FM Moyo, I have noticed that many leaders have really needed this teaching. Our group has been discovering the riches of the Bible, that was hidden to many of them.'

We are passionate about serving local leaders. Often it is the only training and support that many rural leaders receive.

Mandera 'In the past I have not been taught what life can look like as a Pastor. FM has helped me so much, I am no longer confused! I now know my responsibilities and how to serve people as a shepherd who cares, preaches, counsels, and builds relationship with other churches.'

Peter 'As a Pastor I had been going through hard situations, because of a lack of knowledge. I am in FM Moyo which is challenging me to grow. I can say that I was lazy, but I have new priorities to be a role model. I get up early to look after my crops and then I do serve people in the community. I am so thankful for the wisdom I have received through studying.'

Sika 'We have been studying the book of Ruth and her boldness has really inspired me. I have been battling with our culture of not sending children to school and witchcraft. Through FM I feel a courage from the Holy Spirit to restore my life.'

Recent lessons have included teaching on the Holy Spirit, the leaders call to ministry, a leader's character and leaders caring for their family.

Zelesi 'I have learnt a lot on the topic of the leader's secret history. I have been very busy visiting the sick and with discipleship. FM has reminded me of the importance of taking time with God. In His presence I do grow, we talk and He shows me His plans. This gives me purpose and clarity to serve people well.'

One weekend a month we have a Kingdom Expansion weekend where students serve a local church. Teams go visiting homes and praying for the sick. In Mkowa 52 people came to faith and 50 people received healing, 3 of whom regained their hearing!

Lungu 'Two weeks ago I fell in a hole, I have been in a lot of pain and unable to stand. I didn't go to the clinic because I don't have any money, so I was just at home. After you prayed for me all the pain is gone, I can now stand on my leg and more over I am convinced God is real.'
